Improving ones smile:

Please discuss any concerns you may have with the appearance of your teeth with your dentist. The causes of an unattractive smile may be due to the colour, position or shape of your teeth; or the fillings, crowns, veneers that they may already have been restored with. Successful treatment needs to deal with the underlying reasons, should promote health and involve as little tooth removal as possible. Some options:

- Tooth whitening - no drilling & long term improvement in the colour
- Orthodontic treatment - moves teeth into a more pleasing position. Deals with the underlying problems when teeth are crooked or rotated. No drilling but takes a long time.
- Replace fillings - removing silver or stained fillings usually improves the appearance and is simpler than crowns.
- Old veneers and crowns - often have a poor appearance as the gum shrinks back. Replacing these is usually needed. This is more involved and needs discussing first.

Sometime treatments can involve a combination. It is especially important with aesthetic dentistry to be aware that all options have their limitations and compromises may need to be accepted. It is usually possible to progress from 'bad' to 'good', but to end up with 'excellent' is significantly more challenging and may not be possible without a considerable sacrifice.
